

To All Captains and Players,

We will have 5 weeks of match play where your team will compete against the other teams in your flight in a round robin format. Flights and seeding are based on your regular season performance to par.

Flights C and D will have a BYE week. During your bye week, you can play 5 players for fun. There are holes assigned for the bye teams.

Here are few important notes:

- 1. TEE TIMES START AT 5:00 PM BEGINNING AUG 7TH!**
- 2. STARTING HOLE ASSIGNMENTS CHANGE EACH WEEK** – check the schedule at <http://www.highlandsmensclub.com/images/matchplayschedule.pdf> or call the Pro Shop at 208-773-3673 for your starting hole.
- 3. ONLY 4 PLAYERS EACH WEEK** - You must decide prior to arriving at the tee box which 4 players will be participating that week. The remaining players on your team may NOT bring clubs to the hole and may follow as spectators if they adhere to the following:
 - a. They are courteous and not disruptive to the players
 - b. They cannot at any time swing a club or hit a ball
 - c. They are not allowed on the greens.
 - d. Only the 2 team members playing that hole can offer advice to their fellow teammate.

Any infraction of these may cause a forfeit of any or all four matches

- 4. ARRIVING LATE** – Any player(s) not on the tee box ready to play at the starting time will lose the first hole by default. If they are not on the second tee box when it's their turn to hit, they will forfeit the entire match and cannot play during the round.
- 5. NO SUBSTITUTES! - NO SUBSTITUTES! - NO SUBSTITUTES! - NO SUBSTITUTES!**
Your current score card reflects your team roster as it will remain for the rest of the season. During Match Play there are absolutely no substitutes allowed.
- 6. SCORING / SCORECARDS** – Each packet will contain 2 scorecards which will have the team roster with current 9-hole handicaps for the side being played. These are used to determine the match pairings and for the players use during the round. Do not turn these in, scores do not count only the results of the match matter.
- 7. There will be an OFFICIAL SCORECARD** in only one of the team packets which must be signed by a representative of each team and turned in immediately following the completion of the matches. On it you will fill in the two team names, competitors for each of the 4 matches and indicate who won each match by circling the name (circle both names in the case of a tie).
